

Annex 2: Procedure for determining the suitability for a specific degree programme

1. The prerequisite for participation in the procedure for determining the degree programme-specific aptitude is a complete application in due form and time and proof of the qualification requirements according to § 4.
2. Applicants who fulfil the requirements according to § 4 will be admitted to the application procedure.
3. Within the framework of the procedure for determining the suitability for a specific degree programme, the submitted documents are reviewed and evaluated according to the following scheme.
